A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Maybe you saw this, or read it. The New York Times published an oped the Friday before Easter that proposed eliminating God — as one of the holiest weekends of the year was just getting started. The article was titled "In This Time of War, I Propose We Give Up God," the article claimed that God is responsible for "war and violence" and for "oppression and suffering," and suggests that people stop teaching children about Him. The "journalist" behind the article was Shalom Auslander, a disillusioned, now non practicing Jew, bemoaning his own upbringing in an uptight religious Jewish community in New York. He states, "God, it seems, paints with a wide brush. He paints with a roller. In Egypt, said our rabbi, he even killed first-born *cattle*. He killed cows. If he were mortal, the God of Jews, Christians and Muslims would be dragged to The Hague. And yet we praise him. We emulate him. We implore our children to be like him. Perhaps now, as missiles rain down and the dead are discovered in mass graves, is a good time to stop emulating this hateful God. Perhaps we can stop extolling his brutality. Perhaps now is a good time to teach our children to pass over God — to be as unlike him as possible. Killing gods is an idea I can get behind." Wow! And I've got news for him... his idea of teaching our kids not to "emulate" Him has been going on a while now, and just where has that gotten us? And as far as killing Him, that was tried once too and He rose up from the grave and is alive today! And all because He loves you, and He loves me, and He loves the Shalom Auslander's of the world that would dismiss and seek to destroy Him, and He desires to save you and be in a relationship with you to bless you, not to curse you. To be honest, this anti-God/anti-Christian, article didn't surprise me or catch me off guard at all. These kinds of articles it seems get published in major newspapers and media outlets every year just before Easter. It's like they know that if they destroy the cross and the resurrection they can undercut Christianity and the message... the good news of Jesus Christ. It is the propaganda of our very liberal and irreligious press today that likes to promote the idea of doing away with Christians and their ideas. So, it's not surprising to be frank. But it is disturbing... very disturbing none-the-less, and leaves us wondering what kind of world we are living in. Right?

What kind of world are we living in? That is a question that we find ourselves scratching our head over often today it seems. At least to me, anyway! The truth is we are living in a "fallen" one. I know that may sound a bit erudite and maybe even a somewhat cliché, but none the less true. We are living in a Romans 1 world described in God's Word this way, "²¹ Although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. ²² Professing to be wise, they became fools, ²³ and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things. ²⁴ Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among

themselves, ²⁵ who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. ²⁶ For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. ²⁷Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due. ²⁸ And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; ²⁹ being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; they are whisperers, 30 backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, 31 undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful." (Romans 1:21-31) Now, I know that is a lengthy passage, but it is an accurate and truthful picture of the kind of world we live in today. That's where we are, folks! Later in 2 Timothy 3:1-5 Paul would actually issue it as a warning to us... the kind of world we would find ourselves in during these "last days." He wrote, "But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ³ unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!" (2 *Timothy 3:1-5)*

These things are played out daily before our eyes in the form of all sorts of sexually deviant behaviors that are mine boggling, even seeking to teach sexual orientation and gender identity curriculum to children as young as 5 years old in kindergarten. We see it in the moral decline of our country certainly, but also in the radical agenda that would stifle free speech and freedom of thought, that seeks to silence the voice Christians and the church, that stokes the flames of racial division through things like CRT being taught in our school and promoted even in our government institutions, in the military, in corporate America. We even see something as innocent as Disney seeking to promote these radical ideas and agenda. And we scratch our heads and say, "What kind of world are living in?" Another headline that recently caught my attention read like this, "California Bill AB2223 Would Allow Killing Babies in Infanticide Up to 28 Days After Birth." You read that right, California is actually about to pass into a law a bill that would allow the killing of a baby up to 28 days after they are born. Not only do we have the killing of innocent babies still in the supposed safety of their mothers womb... according to the National Right to Life Committee 2.430 babies are killed through abortion every single day in the United States... but now up to 28 days after they are born. What kind of world are we living in that kills innocent babies in their mother's womb and now up to 28 days after they are born? A very, very fallen one!

Can I tell you something else about "the kind of world we are living in today"? We are not only living in a fallen world. We are living in a loved world. We are living in the kind of world today that Jesus died for, that God sent His only begotten Son to die for! Huh! "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16) We are living in the kind of world today that needs the gospel of Jesus Christ to be shared with it! We are living in the exact kind of world that God would have us as believers and as the church be His hands and feet to, ministering the hope of Jesus Christ to their needs, to reach them with the good news, to draw them to Christ, to show them the truth of God's love for them. Our prayer should be, "Lord, help me to be who you have called me to be in the kind of world you have placed me in!" Then let's get busy and do it! God bless & I love you, Bro. Buddy
