
### WMU

## A Word From Our Pastor

Did you know that Easter is the second most important candy-eating occasion of the year for Americans, who consume 7 billion pounds of candy each year at Easter, according to the National Confectioner's Association. In one Easter season, Americans spend nearly \$1.9 billion on Easter candy. Ninety million chocolate Easter bunnies are produced each year. Each Easter season, Americans buy more than 700 million yellow Marshmallow Peeps, shaped like chicks, as well as Marshmallow Bunnies and Marshmallow Eggs, making them the most popular nonchocolate Easter candy. And did you know that Americans consume 16 billion jellybeans at Easter? If all the Easter jellybeans were lined end to end, they would circle the earth nearly three times. Just some fun facts and information about how "sweet" Easter is! But Easter candy, peeps, candy eggs, chocolate bunnies and jelly beans... even in these large quantities is not the sweetest thing about Easter. Let me tell you what is so sweet about East-

Easter is so sweet because the cross, just a few days before, was so bitter. Jesus gave His life for you and me on a cruel cross, filled with suffering, anguish and pain.
